What is CONASEP?

CONASEP is the student exchange program of the Consortium for North American Higher Education Collaboration (CONAHEC). It was created as a way for undergraduate and graduate students studying at one of the member institutions of the consortium to take part in an academic experience abroad for a full semester or an academic year.

Since 2003, CONASEP has allowed **nearly 2,300 students** to have an international academic experience. Today, the program has expanded and now allows the exchange of students to and from institutions in 17 countries.

Participation Process

Universities who wish to participate in this program must:

- a) Be a member of CONAHEC.
- b) Be up-to-date with the payment of the membership.
- c) Notify CONAHEC in a timely manner of their desire to participate in the following call for nominations.
- d) Provide complete and relevant information about their availability to receive exchange students

To be nominated, students must comply with the following requirements:

- a) Demonstrate fluency on the language of instruction at the host institution.
- b) Be in good academic standing GPA of 8.0/10 (Mex); 2.8 (U.S.A. / CAN)

Student Exchange Program Policies

- Each institution may nominate a maximum of two students to a single institution. Overall, each institution may nominate up to 10 students or up to the number of students received from other Institutions (In the case of universities that have received more students through CONASEP than they have sent, they may nominate an unlimited number of students to go abroad through CONASEP until they reach a zero balance again.)
- Institutions do not need to have a signed cooperation agreement among them to exchange students.
- Each student is responsible to pay for the regular tuition at his/her home institution. There will be no monetary transaction between the home and host universities.
- CONAHEC does not charge an administrative fee for processing students' applications. To the best of their ability, institutions should make an effort not to charge an admission fee to students. However, CONAHEC respects the internal policies of its members.
- Host institutions may directly charge admitted students any mandatory fees (other than tuition) established for all international exchange students.
- Each student is responsible to pay for transportation to the study abroad destination, local transportation, room and board, health insurance and other personal expenses.

Important dates

- August 15th to September 15th: First round of student nominations/applications.
- September 16th to 30th: Universities that received applications must select the best candidates and approve or reject all received applications previously authorized by CONAHEC.
- October 1st to 30th: Second round of nominations/applications.
- November 1st to 15th: Universities that received applications must select the best candidates and approve or reject all received applications previously authorized by CONAHEC.
- November 16th to December 1st: If there are still
 available spaces at some institutions whose deadlines
 for submitting applications haven't expired,
 Universities can keep sending applications which will
 be processed and authorized on a first come, first
 served basis.

Process

- Before each call for applications, participating institutions must submit information related to their availability to receive international exchange students. An electronic form must be filled out at the CONASEP website with the following information:
 - a. Number of available spaces per academic level (undergraduate and/or graduate).
 - b. Academic fields available.
 - c. Deadline to receive applications.
 - d. Language requirements.
 - e. Amount and description of any mandatory fees that must be covered by the admitted students.
 - f. Estimated monthly cost of living for students (housing, meals, local transportation, etc.)
- 2. Interested students, along with the international programs officer responsible at their institution, select the university and program of interest.
 - At this point, it is recommended that the home institution (not the student) contacts the host institution to clarify any specific details regarding the exchange, courses, credit transfers, etc.

- 3. Home institution submits an application through the CONASEP website.
- 4. CONAHEC reviews the application and responds in no more than 72hrs. Applications are approved by CONAHEC if:
 - a. The home institution:
 - Is indeed participating in the program.
 - It's up-to-date with the membership payment.
 - b. The host institution:
 - Still has available places.
 - The due date for submitting applications has not expired.
 - c. The student:
 - Has the appropriate GPA and language requirements.
- Once the application has been approved by CONAHEC, the home institution may contact the host institution to ask for further specific requirements or documentation that would be needed if the student is to be admitted.
- 6. The host institutions review all the applications accepted by CONAHEC and selects the best candidates. The institution must accept or reject all the applications within the specified time.
 - a. If a student is admitted: Host institutions contact both the student and his/her home institution (via e-mail) to request any additional information and documents needed to issue an official admission letter.
 - b. If a student is rejected: The host institution must reject the application in the CONASEP website, and in the comments section leave the reasons for rejecting the application so that the home institution can be officially notified.
- Once the host university has received all proper documentation, the status of the application in the CONASEP website must be changed to admitted.


